

## National Advisory Council for Nursing Research (NACNR) Workgroup on Strategies to Strengthen Inclusion in NINR- Supported Research (WGI)

### Charge:

Participation in research is central to optimizing health and wellbeing, minimizing disease, and advancing health equity. It is essential that participation in research be inclusive and diverse in all aspects. The WGI will provide advice to the NACNR on effective strategies to enhance the diversity and inclusion of participants in NINR-supported research.

The WGI will review participant inclusion in NINR-supported studies and consider the range of factors that may affect it, such as PI and research team expertise; research topic; study design, inclusion criteria, and recruitment strategies; and NINR policies and practices (e.g., monitoring of enrollment). The WGI will make suggestions to Council to consider on actions that NINR can take to increase diversity and inclusion among research study participants.
