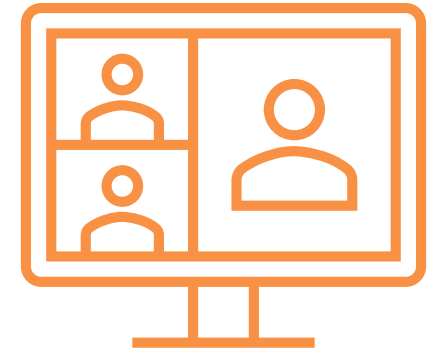
Funding opportunities website views increased by **151%**

Technical assistance webinars averaged **500 registrants**, nearly **250 live views**, and **400 YouTube views**

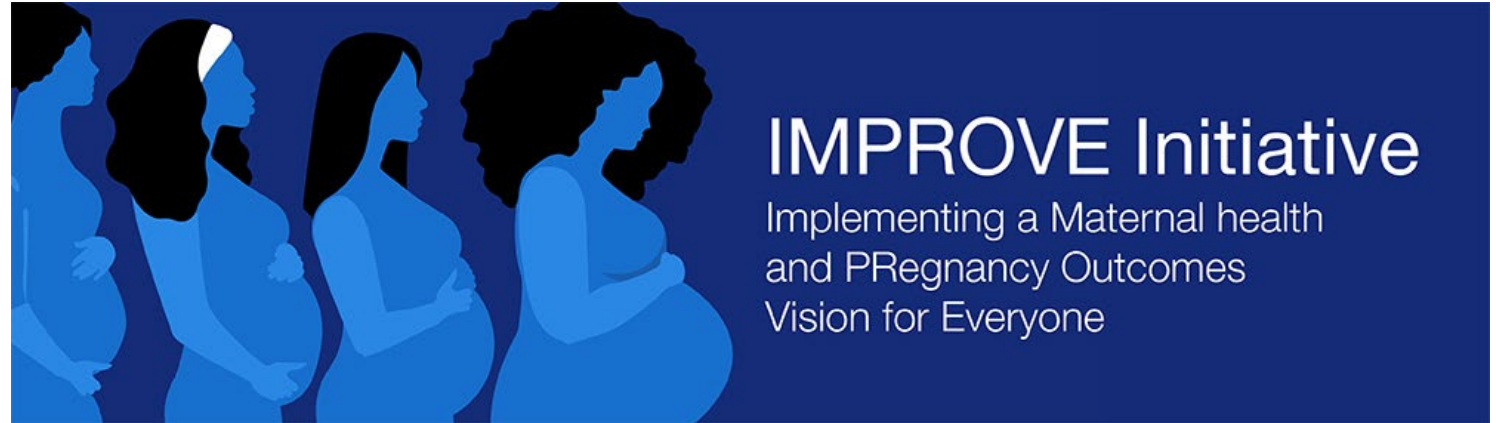
